- ❖ Students will come by appointment for Related Services, evaluations and tutoring, etc.

# INSTRUCTION MODELS

## DEFINITIONS OF INSTRUCTIONAL MODELS

<b>Face-to-Face</b>	Traditional face-to-face with social distancing.
<b>Asynchronous</b>	Independent, online learning without real-time interaction from the teacher. Students learn on their own.
<b>Synchronous</b>	Online learning that happens in real-time. The teacher and groups of students meet for live sessions, activities, and chats.
<b>Traditional</b>	A return to face-to-face instruction at the school building with additional health and safety precautions.
<b>Remote</b>	A continuation of virtual/digital learning at home with adjustments and improvements.
<b>Hybrid</b>	A blended model of instruction that uses both Traditional Learning and Remote Learning.
